Contest Rules and Regulations

- 1. Each contestant will turn in a signed and dated release form. If under 18, you will need a parent or guardian to sign your form.
- 2. Contestants must include a short 1 paragraph bio and one smiling picture with their application.
- 3. Each contestant must sell a minimum of 500 raffle tickets. For every 100 tickets sold after the initial 500 tickets, you will receive one bonus point.
- 4. All unsold tickets and all proceeds from ticket sales must be turned in prior to the last performance (Saturday evening). Contestants are responsible for all tickets and proceeds from those that are assigned to them. Tickets will be sent upon receipt of completed application.
- 5. Each contestant must participate in a personal introduction/interview at one of the GCRC meetings which will be held one evening in the month of June. Committee members will be allowed to ask questions/have conversation regarding rodeo, horses, interests and activities, etc.
- 6. Each contestant must come to practice the week before the rodeo to go over how they will enter and ride in the arena (if able to do so). At this time, the judge will score:
 - a. Horsemanship b. Etiquette

 Please bring the horse you will be using for the rodeo this night!
- 7. Contestants must conduct themselves in a proper ladylike manner and portray high moral standards at all times.
- 8. Contestants are strongly encouraged to attend all GCRC events such as team ropings, barrel races, etc.
- 9. Contestants will provide their own wardrobe and must be of western attire at GCRC events.
- 10. Miss 2024 GCRC Rodeo Queen will be crowned at the Saturday night performance. Must be present or the title will be awarded to the runner up.
- 11. The GCRC reserves the right to alter any rules and has the side of authority over any rule discrepancy.
- 12. Must provide your own horse or ride in the truck.
